### 1. Purpose of This Document

This document provides an indicative overview of pricing principles, engagement models, and cost drivers for Eunoia Mobility's Same-Day & Short-Stay Recovery Mobility services.

Same-Day awareness refers solely to non-clinical pacing, supervision, and coordination considerations and does not involve medical monitoring, assessment, or clinical decision-making.

Pricing balances:

- Patient safety and dignity
- Discharge-aligned coordination and timing sensitivity
- Duty of care and operational risk
- Insurance, compliance, and liability exposure
- Service sustainability and continuity

### 3. Key Pricing Determinants

Final pricing is influenced by one or more of the following factors:









- Type of procedure and anesthesia exposure
- Post-procedure fatigue, nausea, or mobility sensitivity
- Vehicle configuration (WAV, high-roof, securement, climate control)
- Staffing configuration (driver only, attendant, extended recovery support)
- Timing (standard hours, early morning, after-hours)
- Discharge variability and coordination complexity
- Journey structure (one-way, round-trip, multi-stop)
- Access constraints (stairs, non-accessible buildings, long walking distances)
- Inter-emirate travel requirements

All services are planned following structured intake to ensure appropriate resource allocation.

### 5. Factors That May Adjust Pricing

Pricing may increase or decrease based on:

- After-hours or early-morning discharge windows
- Extended PACU or discharge delays beyond grace period
- Same-day fatigue-sensitive pacing requirements
- Bariatric handling or multiple mobility aids
- Inter-emirate coordination
- Extended standby or protected booking windows
- Additional attendants or recovery support bundles

Each journey is reviewed individually to ensure safety and suitability.

### 6. Engagement Models Available

Eunoia Mobility supports multiple engagement structures selected based on discharge pathway, service volume, and coordination complexity.

Per-journey post-procedure transfer is the default engagement model unless discharge timing variability, same-day sensitivity, or frequency of service justify structured short-term or programmatic engagement.

Available engagement models include:

- Per-journey post-procedure transfers
- Same-day discharge and return itineraries
- Multi-stop recovery day blocks
- Medical tourism discharge coordination
- Weekly or short-term recovery programs
- Institutional or contracted service agreements

### 7. Scope of Service & Clinical Boundaries

- Medical assessment or diagnosis
